



Event Guidelines during COVID19 - Autoslalom 2020

Vinland Motorsport Inc. (VMI) is pleased to announce the commencement of 2020 autoslalom events effective June 8, 2020, as per Newfoundland and Labrador COVID - 19 **Alert Level 2 guidelines.**

This guide has been prepared for all club members and participants in VMI events and activities during this period. VMI encourages all involved be pro-active in employing the behaviors and protocols as defined by public health and governing authorities.

Notice to Participants: VMI will make every attempt to minimize the risks of COVID-19 exposure. Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate.

If you are feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, please stay home.

If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

If you or someone within your bubble has been outside of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador within the last two weeks, please stay home.

During VMI events, please take the health and safety of your fellow participants and club volunteers into consideration and utilize best practices.

General Guidelines:

- Follow federal, provincial and municipal guidelines in relation to COVID-19.

- Participants are encouraged to wear masks or face coverings.

- Use disinfection wipes or spray to sanitize equipment, supplies, and shared areas between uses.

- Event will be closed to spectators. Spectators will not be allowed within course or vehicle paddock area.

- Maintain proper social distancing protocols of 2 metres (6 feet). This includes refraining from physical contact such as hugs, handshakes and high-fives.

- PPE supplies such as hand sanitizer and disposal gloves will be available.

- All participants must have their own helmet.

- VMI tech inspectors will wear appropriate PPE including face masks and disposal gloves while performing vehicle tech inspections.



Autoslalom Guidelines:

VMI 2020 autoslalom season will require both staff, volunteers and participants to be vigilant and engaged in adapting to new practices and procedures developed by the club executive directors.

Attendance:

Due to Newfoundland and Labrador COVID-19 Alert **Level 2** rules and regulations, VMI will be limited to **50 participants.**

The likelihood of VMI to fill 50 participants in a single points event is low, therefore registration is open to the public.

Pre-registration is preferred for the VMI 2020 autoslalom season under Level 2. This will allow event officials to prepare and plan the event.

Helmet:

All participants in VMI 2020 autoslalom season will be required to provide their own helmet adhering to one of the following standards: FIA 8860-2004; FIA 8860-2010; FIA 8859-2015; Snell 2015 SA or 2015 M; Snell 2010 SA - 2010 SAH or 2010 M; SFI Foundation 31.1/2015; SFI Foundation 31.1/2010, ECE R22.05/ECE 22.05

ECE helmets are not acceptable for roll caged vehicles



Payment:

All financial transactions for VMI 2020 autoslalom season will be electronic through an online banking e-mail money transfer (EMT).

All payments will be sent to treasurer@vinland.ca; your password will be your club membership number (Example: VMI2020-0000). Payment for non-members will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

Member Registration:

Membership form is available through VMI website. Please email a signed and completed form to secretary@vinland.ca. Use EMT password “vinland” for payment to treasurer.

Single Membership fee - \$40.00

Family Membership fee - \$60.00

Event Registration:

Event pre-registration invites will be emailed to VMI club members via autoslalom@vinland.ca approximately one week before the event is scheduled.

Please note your first event on Bell Island is free.

Club member fee - \$20.00

Day member fee - \$30.00



In order to pre-register for an event:

- 1) Respond to e-mail from autoslalom@vinland.ca indicating your intent to attend autoslalom points event. Day members will be provided with a password upon receipt of their email intent to participate.

- 2) Send payment as soon as possible via EMT to treasurer@vinland.ca. This will be required to secure your spot.

Once EMT is received, the funds will be held until the scheduled day of event. If the event is to proceed, the funds will be deposited by treasurer on the day of event. If the event does not proceed, please cancel your EMT.

Tech Inspection:

Participants will be required to submit a vehicle disclosure form for the vehicle they chose to use, indicating:

- 1) Year/Make/Model/Trim

- 2) Vehicle modifications

VMI course directors will inspect vehicle for classification group and modifications when performing technical inspections.



A participant will be notified if any issues occur with tech inspection. Please note VMI tech inspector has the right to refuse any vehicle from participating in autoslalom events.

Drivers:

Participants will not be permitted any passengers unless passenger is within immediate bubble.

Co-driving a vehicle will not be permitted unless each driver is within immediate bubble.

Autoslalom Event:

Participants will arrive at Portugal Cove ferry terminal on the morning of the scheduled event as specified by VMI. A link to the Bell Island ferry fees can be found at the end of this document.

Once on Bell Island, please proceed to the Bell Island Airport in a respectable manner. Please adhere to all road signs and posted speed limits.

VMI expects all event participants to be active in course setup, removal, and safety marshalling. All participants will be required to attend the pre-event drivers meeting and course walk.



Autoslalom points events will consist of four timed runs and additional fun runs if available at end of day. A paper copy of the course map will be provided to participants at the event.

Fastest rookie participant will be presented a rookie-of-the-day certificate by VMI executive.

Points will be awarded following this structure: 1st place (9 points), 2nd place (6 points), 3rd place (4 points), 4th place (3 points), 5th place (1 point)

Event results will be communicated via club website and social media pages.
